

**The Privacy Policy for visitors applies to everyone who visits the website [www.thehagueevents.com](http://www.thehagueevents.com).**

### **1. Management**

The website [www.thehagueevents.com](http://www.thehagueevents.com) is managed by Duynisveld Events & Communicatie. The contact details can be found on the aforementioned website.

### **2. Data from visitors**

2a Some data resulting from one or more visits to [www.thehagueevents.com](http://www.thehagueevents.com) are kept permanently, but anonymously. This data will therefore never be traceable to a person or to an organization.

2b The Hague Events ensures good security of the stored data.

### **3. Cookies**

3a The Hague Events uses functional cookies to optimize the functionality of certain pages of the website. Cookies are small text files that are placed on the visitor's computer by a page of the website. Such a cookie stores information such as certain preferences of the visitors. As a result, The Hague Events can provide the visitor with a better service during a subsequent visit, for example through the domain names that the visitor has checked and saved.

3b The visitor can determine for himself how cookies should be handled. He or she can configure his browser so that it does allow, does not allow or partially allow the use of functional cookies. In the latter case, it's possible to set which websites may place functional cookies. It will then be prohibited for all other websites. This option is provided by the most common modern browsers.

3c Cookies can always be removed from a computer, again via the browser.

3d The Hague Events also uses marketing cookies to make the communication of The Hague Events more personal on its own site and to better attune it to the wishes of the individual customer.

3e The Hague Events uses Analytics cookies that do not process the surfing behavior of individuals, but of large numbers of visitors-anonymized – into graphs and patterns that help us to improve and optimize our website.

## **5. Disclaimer**

The Hague Events is entitled to change the content of the Privacy Policy without the visitor being informed. The implementation of the change on the website is sufficient for this.

## **6. Information provided by the customer**

The Hague Events can use the data provided by the customer for the following purposes: Processing a request for services.

## **7. Providing data to third parties**

Data provided by the customer to The Hague Events will never be passed on the third parties. There are however exceptions to this rule:

- When a court order has been issued to provide information.

## **8. Security**

The data that the customer provides to The Hague Events are stored in a secure environment.

## **9. Adjustment of customer data**

The customer has the possibility to change the information provided at any time. The Hague Events can ask the customer in such case to pass on the change in a manner prescribed by The Hague Events and in some cases identification may be required.
